Chair & BCCSL report - Sev

- No written report.
- Alouette District Board voted to dissolve. Alouette district clubs will join other neighboring districts.
- Recent BCCSL meeting addressed new BCSPL U11/U12 High Performance League. Chris Cerroni
 of BC Soccer attended. CSA supports the initiative. Debate about whether to run the new
 league through BCSPL or BCCSL it was decided that BCCSL would run the new league. The
 BCCSL Board decided that it would <u>not</u> schedule any non-District member affiliated clubs to play
 in the new U11/U12 league this includes regular league play and friendlies.
- Mountain FC has collaborated with the Burnaby District and will officially join the Burnaby district for Sept 2021.
- TSS is collaborating with the Richmond District and is expected to apply for membership to the Richmond District in Sept 2021 for membership in the Richmond District in the 2022/23 season.
- VAFC is partnering with TSS for the new 2021/22 season U11/U12 League.
- Fusion FC has not collaborated with any district.
- Other Districts were supportive of the VYSA, and that Fusion should collaborate with the district if they wish to participate in the BCCSL at U11/U12.
- Canada Soccer has a spotlight on the new U11/U12 League and wants it to go forward; however, it will not happen in 2021 or 2022. The new league will not operate for the U11/12 season.
- Although Fusion may have formed U11 & U12 teams, at this time, these teams are not affiliated to play for the 2021/22 BCCSL season.

Secretary-Treasurer Report - David

- David delivered Treasurer report & reviewed April financial statements.
- At the start of season, we projected a deficit of \$29,730 due primarily to lower registrations and higher administrative costs. We now project a surplus of just under \$29,000 after accounting for legal costs. The surplus is primarily due to a reduction of administrative costs after staff changes and a reduction in referee costs due to significantly less games due to Covid the past season.
